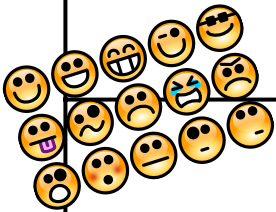
Bake a cake together. Count the spoonfuls of each ingredient.
