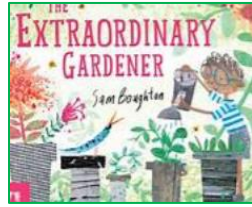




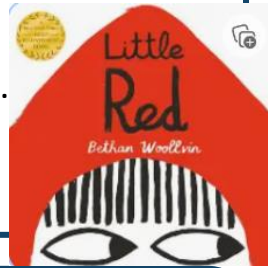

Curriculum News

Our topics are 'Kings and Queens' and 'Stories from the past'

During our Kings and Queens project children will learn about our monarch, King Charles III. They will become familiar with some key features of our monarchy including people in the Royal Family, special places and traditions, including the kings love of the environment. Children will begin to understand that the title of King or Queen is passed down through the Royal Family. This is an opportunity to introduce some historical concepts and also allows the children to explore art, stories and music. We also hope to visit Hughenden Manor as an opportunity to visit a grand house and its gardens.

Our final topic of the year will introduce Reception children to some fascinating story types including fairy tales, legends, Ancient Greek myths, fables and folk tales. We've chosen a purposefully ambitious mix of story types, to enjoy a wide range of stories and to begin to understand the variety and diversity within the wonderful world of storytelling.
